

# Camino Restaurant - Plaster



Camino Restaurant in Oakland, California wanted a custom plaster to serve as a focal point in their new eatery. Long time collaborator J. Fisher worked with the clients to choose a color and texture that compliment the many natural surfaces in the space. For this project we utilized a Natural Hydraulic Lime project imported by Trans Mineral USA. Its aggregate size allows for some shadows in to appear on close examination, while still being smooth to the touch. Camino opened in 2008



Applying lime plasters on to sheetrock requires a delicate hand and attention to detail, mixes must be made in small batches to control reactivity. Masking is necessary to prevent drops of stray material staining adjacent surfaces.



Capturing the afternoon sun, the plasters charm lies in its old world aesthetic. Smooth sections pass naturally to exposed aggregates.
